According to the plain text of the King James Bible, Michael has specific identifying characteristics, for as the name is, so is the person [1 Samuel 25:25 KJB] [anything in brackets is for clarification, and will be demonstrated later]:

**[01]** Michael helped Gabriel [a lesser arch-angel] overcome “the prince of the kingdom of Persia” [Satan, a lesser arch-angel] in Daniel 10:13 KJB who had been attempting to get the Kings of Persia to resist the prophetic command of God in Daniel 9:24-27 KJB.

**[02]** Michael withstood “the prince of the kingdom of Persia” [Satan, the devil, a lesser arch-angel] so that Gabriel [a lesser arch-angel] could be free to come to the prophet Daniel and explain the vision of Daniel 8-9.

**[03]** Michael is designated as “one of the chief princes” in Daniel 10:13 KJB.

**[04]** Michael is greater in knowledge of the prophetic events given in “the scripture of truth” than Gabriel [a lesser arch-angel] is, per Daniel 10:21 KJB.

**[05]** Michael is designated as “your [Daniel & Israel's] prince” in Daniel 10:21 KJB.

**[06]** Michael is designated “the great prince which standeth for the children of thy [Daniel's] people [Israel]” in Daniel 12:1 KJB.

**[07]** When Michael “shall ... stand up”, at the end of the prophetic events in Daniel 8-11 KJB, the “time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation *even* to that same time” commences and “at that time thy [Daniel's] people [Israel] shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book [being the book of Life of the Lamb].” as given in Daniel 12:1 KJB.

**[08]** When Michael “shall ... stand up” a special resurrection of some specific righteous and some specific wicked takes place in Daniel 12:2 KJB.

The parallel passage of Daniel 12:1 is Luke 13:25 KJB and Genesis 6 KJB:

Luke 13:25 KJB - **When once the master of the house is risen up, and**

hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

Matthew 24:37 KJB - But as the days of Noe *were*, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

Luke 17:26 KJB - And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man.

Genesis 6:11 KJB - The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

Genesis 6:12 KJB - And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

Genesis 6:13 KJB - And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

Genesis 6:18 KJB - But with thee will I establish my covenant; and thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee.

[09] The “voice of the archangel”, being directly linked to “The Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout”, “the trump of God” and “Christ”, causes the resurrection of the general righteous in 1 Thessalonians 4:16 KJB.

The parallel passage of 1 Thessalonians 4:16 KJB is John 5:25,28,29 KJB:

John 5:25 KJB - Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.

John 5:28 KJB - Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,

John 5:29 KJB - And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

[10] Michael is designated “the archangel” in Jude 1:9 KJB.

[11] Michael was “contending with the devil [a lesser arch-angel]” over the resurrection of Moses in Jude 1:9 KJB.

[12] Michael “durst not”, when “contending with the devil [a lesser arch-angel]” over the resurrection of Moses, “bring against him [the devil, a lesser arch-angel] a railing accusation” in Jude 1:9 KJB.

[13] Michael, when “contending with the devil [a lesser arch-angel]” over the resurrection of Moses, said, “The Lord rebuke thee [the devil, a lesser arch-angel].” in Jude 1:9 KJB.

[14] Michael fought the “war in heaven” against “the dragon [the devil, a lesser arch-angel]” in Revelation 12:7 KJB.

[15] Michael has “his angels” that fought against “the dragon [the devil, a lesser arch-angel]” in Revelation 12:7 KJB.

[16] Michael “prevailed” in Revelation 12:8 KJB over “the dragon [the devil, a lesser arch-angel]” in that “war in heaven”.

[17] Michael “cast out [of Heaven]” “the dragon [the devil, a lesser arch-angel] and his angels” in Revelation 12:9 KJB.

The name of Michael [H4317] means “Who is like unto God?” [[1] H4310, [2] H3588, and [3] H410]. Are there any other scriptures in the King James Bible which address this? Yes.

Exodus 15:11 KJB - Who *is* like unto thee, O LORD, among the gods? who *is* like thee, glorious in holiness, fearful *in* praises, doing wonders?

Job 36:22 KJB - Behold, God exalteth by his power: who teacheth like him?

Psalms 35:10 KJB - All my bones shall say, LORD, who *is* like unto thee, which deliverest the poor from him that is too strong for him, yea, the poor and the needy from him that spoileth him?

Psalms 71:19 KJB - Thy righteousness also, O God, *is* very high, who hast done great things: O God, who *is* like unto thee!

Psalms 89:8 KJB - O LORD God of hosts, who *is* a strong LORD like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee?

Psalms 113:5 KJB - Who *is* like unto the LORD our God, who dwelleth on high,

Psalms 86:8 KJB - **Among the gods there is none like unto thee, O Lord; neither are there any works like unto thy works.**

Jeremiah 10:6 KJB - Forasmuch as **there is none like unto thee, O LORD**; thou *art* great, and thy name *is* great in might.

Jeremiah 10:7 KJB - Who would not fear thee, **O King of nations**? for to thee doth it appertain: forasmuch as among all the wise *men* of the nations, and in all their kingdoms, **there is none like unto thee.**

The designation “the archangel”, in relationship to “Michael” [“Who is like unto God?”], means ‘the chief messenger’ or even ‘the highest messenger’, yet it can also signify one who is in command over others.

A “messenger” is one who is “sent”:

**Genesis** 32:2, 50:6; **Numbers** 20:14, 21:21, 22:5; **Deuteronomy** 2:26; **Joshua** 6:17,25, 7:22; **Judges** 6:35, 7:24, 9:31, 11:12,14,17,19; **1 Samuel** 6:21, 11:3,7, 16:19, 19:11,14,15,20,21, 25:14; **2 Samuel** 2:5, 3:14,26, 5:11, 11:4,22, 12:27; **1 Kings** 19:2, 20:2,5,9; **2 Kings** 1:2,16, 5:10, 6:32, 14:8, 16:7, 17:4, 19:9; **1 Chronicles** 14:1, 19:2,16; **2 Chronicles** 36:15; **Nehemiah** 6:3; **Proverbs** 17:11, 25:13; **Isaiah** 37:9, 42:19, 57:9; **Jeremiah** 27:3; **Ezekiel** 23:16,40; **Malachi** 3:1; **Matthew** 11:10; **Mark** 1:2; **Luke** 7:27, 9:52; **Philippians** 2:25; **James** 2:25 KJB

John 8:42 KJB - Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.

John 8:47 KJB - He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear *them* not, because ye are not of God.

John 8:49 KJB - Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.

John 8:50 KJB - And I seek not mine own glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth.

John 8:51 KJB - Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.

John 8:55 KJB - Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying.

John 10:32 KJB - Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me?

John 10:36 KJB - Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

John 12:44 KJB - Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me.

John 12:45 KJB - And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me.

John 12:47 KJB - And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

John 12:48 KJB - He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

John 12:49 KJB - For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.

John 12:50 KJB - And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak.

John 16:5 KJB - But now I go my way to him that sent me; and none of you asketh me, Whither goest thou?

John 16:7 KJB - Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

John 16:12 KJB - I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.

John 16:13 KJB - Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

John 16:14 KJB - He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew *it* unto you.

John 16:15 KJB - All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew *it* unto you.

John 16:27 KJB - For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God.

John 16:28 KJB - I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.

John 17:3 KJB - And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.

John 17:4 KJB - I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

John 17:6 KJB - I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.

John 17:7 KJB - Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee.

John 17:8 KJB - For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received *them*, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.

John 17:13 KJB - And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

John 17:14 KJB - I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

John 17:17 KJB - Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

John 17:18 KJB - As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

John 17:21 KJB - That they all may be one; as thou, Father, *art* in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

John 17:23 KJB - **I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.**

John 17:25 KJB - **O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.**

John 17:26 KJB - **And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare *it*: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.**

John 20:21 KJB - Then said Jesus to them again, **Peace *be* unto you: as *my* Father hath sent me, even so send I you.**

Acts 2:33 KJB - Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

Galatians 4:14 KJB - And my temptation which was in my flesh ye despised not, nor rejected; but received me as an angel of God, *even* as Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 3:1 KJB - Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;

Hebrews 3:2 KJB - Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses *was faithful* in all his house.

Hebrews 10:7 KJB - Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God.

Hebrews 10:9 KJB - Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second.

1 John 1:5 KJB - This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

1 John 3:11 KJB - For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

1 John 4:14 KJB - And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son *to be* the Saviour of the world.

Revelation 1:1 KJB - The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *it* by his angel unto his servant John:

Revelation 5:6 KJB - And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Who then is the one [Michael] “Who is like unto God?” [the archangel] “the chief [highest] messenger” of God, the Father? Who is the one “like unto” God, the Father, the “express image” [Hebrews 1:3 KJB] thereof, being “the Word” [John 1:1 KJB], and was “sent” from the Father with a message, with “good news” [Proverbs 25:25 KJB], the “glad” and “good” “tidings” [Daniel 11:44; Nahum 1:5; Luke 8:1; Romans 10:15 KJB] of the “gospel” [Mark 1:1, etc. KJB] from a “far country” [Isaiah 13:5; Matthew 21:33, 25:14; Mark 12:1; Luke 19:12, 20:9 KJB]?
